## <u>Truths</u>

- When should I pray? 6:18 praying at all times in the Spirit
- Praying at all times is more of a posture than a pause.

Q: Why would we be in a constant posture of prayerfulness? A: Because life is a spiritual warzone.

- 2. The Breastplate Called Hard-Heart
- 3. The Sword of an Evil Tongue
- 4. The Shield of Unbelief
- 5. A Prayerless Spirit<sup>1</sup>
  - How should I pray?
    - 1) Operate in a mindset of prayer 6:18a *praying at all times in the Spirit,*
    - 2) Use everything in the prayer arsenal 6:18b with all prayer and supplication
    - 3) Stay alert and persevere 6:18c To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints,
- Q: How do I pray for others?
- A: "Supplication" urgent request to meet a need, exclusively addressed to God.<sup>2</sup>

- ► Conviction of sin: Pray for God to open their eyes.
- Perseverance in suffering
- "The bond of fellowship which united the people of God is never more effective than when they are praying for one another." F. F. Bruce<sup>3</sup>
  - Victory over temptation

  - ▶ Boldness and wisdom to stay on mission 6:19-20 and also for me, that <u>words</u> may be given to me in opening my mouth <u>boldly to</u> <u>proclaim</u> the mystery of the gospel, <sup>20</sup> for which I am an ambassador in chains, that I may <u>declare it boldly</u>, as I ought to speak.
