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LIVE OUT THE NEW NORMAL.

Colossians 2:4-7

I say this in order that no one may delude you with plausible arguments. ⁵ For though I am absent in body, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the firmness of your faith in Christ. ⁶ Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

Heads up...

• Beware of <u>sugar</u>-coated sayings – 2:4 I say this in order that no one may delude you with plausible arguments.

Romans 16:17-18

I appeal to you, brothers, to watch out for those who cause divisions and create obstacles contrary to the doctrine that you have been taught; avoid them. ¹⁸ For such persons do not serve our Lord Christ, but their own appetites, and by **smooth talk** and flattery they deceive the hearts of the naive.

Ephesians 5:6

Let no one <u>deceive</u> you with empty words, for because of these things the wrath of God comes upon the sons of disobedience.

James 1:26 If anyone thinks he is religious and does not bridle his tongue but <u>deceives</u> his heart, this person's religion is worthless.

Colossians 4:6

Let your speech always be gracious, **<u>seasoned with salt</u>**, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

• Be aware your <u>discipline</u> and <u>firm</u> faith inspire others – 2:5 For though I am absent in body, yet I am with you in spirit, rejoicing to see your good order and the firmness of your faith in Christ.

1 Peter 5:8–9

Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.⁹ Resist him, <u>firm in your faith</u>, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world.

What does the new normal look like?

1) <u>Receive</u> Christ – 2:6 *Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him,*

2) Walk in grace – 2:6 Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him,

3) Walk in <u>strength</u> – 2:7a rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught,

4) Walk in thanksgiving – 2:7b *abounding in thanksgiving*.
