A GENUINE CHRISTIAN IS ONE WHO HAS BEEN GENUINELY CHANGED BY THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST.

- c. Moral Max "I'm honest, respectable, a good neighbor, give to charity, etc. Obviously, I'm a Christian, right?"
- d. Liturgical Larry "I participate in church services. So, I'm a Christian, right?"
- e. #Murica Mike "I was born in the USA. Therefore, I'm a Christian, right?"

## What is a genuine Christian?

John 1:12-13

But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God, <sup>13</sup> who were born, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but of God.

We all have a need that only Jesus can fulfill. What is that need?
 Forgiveness of our sins and a right relationship with God.

- Adoption into the family of God is free to all who would receive Jesus as Savior – 1:12a But to all who did receive him,
- <u>faith</u> and <u>trust</u> in Jesus alone 1:12b But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God,
