DO ALL ROADS LEAD TO GOD?

"It appears to us that *this* was our Lord's meaning—"I am the way to God." That is the great teaching—"No man comes to the Father but by Me and I am the way in this respect—that no man can come to know the truth with regard to the Father except He knows Me as the truth; and, secondly, no man can possess the life by which He comes to the Father except He receives Me as the life. *I am the way to the Father in a double sense—of being the truth which teaches men about the Father and being the life which enables men to come to the Father and have practical communion."" – Charles Spurgeon*

How does knowing "The Way" affect how we live?

• Your heart doesn't have to <u>sink</u> in constant <u>turmoil</u> – 14:1a *Let not your hearts be troubled...*

• Your <u>mind</u> has an <u>anchor</u> in the foundation of the Universe – 14:1b ...Believe in God; believe also in me.

 Your life isn't <u>crippled</u> by the fear of death: You have an <u>expectation</u> for what lies beyond the world – 14:2-6
