JOHN 13:18-38

LOVE AS CHRIST HAS LOVED YOU.

<u>Love & Betrayal</u>

- Jesus predicts <u>betrayal</u>, Judas betrays Jesus, and <u>everyone</u> else totally misses it – 13:18-20
- Jesus <u>warns</u> the disciples of betrayal so that they would <u>believe</u> in Him.
- God makes room for human responsibility but is not derailed by human evil.
- Jesus is troubled, Satan enters Judas, disciples stay confused, and it get dark – 13:21-38
- Jesus makes clear a new commandment: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another – 13:31-35
- Jesus calls Peter's bluff 13:36-38

<u>Takeaways:</u>

- Betrayal will come.
- Betrayal will not break God's plan.
- Betrayal must not make us bitter.
- Betrayal should remind us not to think we are **<u>stronger</u>** than we are.
- Betrayal should remind us of Jesus' trustworthiness.
- Q: So what then?
- A: In a fallen world let your mark be your love for one another, so love as Christ has loved you.
