A Christian case for good people skills

1 Peter 4:15-16

But let none of you suffer as a murderer or a thief or an evildoer or as a meddler. ¹⁶ Yet if anyone suffers as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in that name.

Matthew 5:11-12

Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you **falsely** on my account. ¹² Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
